Dear Parent/Carer

As we prepare for a very different start to the new academic year we thought it would be a good idea to send a letter with some of the key points you will need to know for the first few days back. We know we have had to send so much information at the end of the summer term and want to give you a quick overview. We are also resending the entrance and exit plans for each school.

- In line with government guidance we have a staggered start and end to the day – please see the attached information to ensure you arrive at the correct time and entrance. You now only have a 10 minute drop off and pick up window.
- We would please ask that all adults observe social distancing within the school grounds.
- Currently we will not be able to allow parents to meet with teachers, if you have a query or need to speak the teacher please email the school office and a phone call or video call will be arranged.
- Please make sure that you have prepared your child to leave you quickly at the drop off point – if your child is having difficulties doing this members of Senior Leadership Team will support you to a designated area, although please bear in mind they will not be able to break social distancing due to our in school bubbles.
- We support your decision to wear a mask on the school grounds. However in line with government guidance, we will not require you to wear one as you will be outside.
- We are unable to allow scooters or bikes to be left on site during the day so they will have to be taken off site by parents if being ridden to school. We are looking at further ways to facilitate this in the future.
- A final few reminders – school dinners will currently be packed lunches eaten in the classroom. No P.E. Kits need to be bought in for the first few weeks. Children will each have their own pack of equipment and KS2 children are able to bring in their own pencil case but they must not share equipment with classmates.
