UNIFORM LIST

Maroon jogging bottoms (**Nursery and Reception ONLY**)

WOULD PARENTS PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

NO fashion boots to be worn in school.

When purchasing a coat or anorak, black, navy blue or burgundy is preferred.

For safety reasons no open toe sandals.

In order for all children to fully access the Nursery and Reception curriculum all children must wear jogging bottoms or shorts. No dresses or skirts for girls please.

Jewellery

Children must not wear jewellery to school for safety and security reasons. A named watch may be worn. Earrings must be studs and must be removed for all PE games and swimming lessons.
