Reading at home - new online learning.

What is Reading Planet Online?

Reading Planet Online offers the Reading Planet books in digital format, so that these can be assigned to your child and read online at school or at home on any internet-enabled device.

The books in Reading Planet are designed to appeal to the tastes and interests of children who are starting to learn to read, as well as those who are becoming fluent readers. The books include a variety of fiction, non-fiction, poetry and plays, written by experienced educational and children's writers. All the books have been carefully levelled according to book banding and other criteria, to ensure gradual progression in difficulty.

Each eBook features an optional audio recording (with each word highlighted as it is read) and a variety of quizzes to check children's understanding of what they have read.



Children will receive login details for Reading Planet in their contact books soon.

Year 2 Assessments

- ▶ **Year 2 children will sit their Phonics Screening Check (they should have completed this in June in Year 1) in Autumn 2. They will be having daily phonics lessons to ensure that they have a sound knowledge of all the phonics they should know. If your child doesn't pass, they will resit the Phonics Screening Check in June.**
- ▶ **Year 2 SATS will still take place in Summer 2021. We will be working towards the expected standards for Year 2.**
- ▶ **There will be further information on SATS when we receive more information from the DFE.**
