# PE days

- ▶ PE lessons will take place on the following days:
- ▶ Pine- Tuesday and Wednesday
- ▶ Acer- Tuesday and Wednesday

**Please remember that children will be required to wear their PE kits to school on that day and they will not need to bring in trainers for the remaining days.**

# Behaviour expectations

- ▶ Each day, every child will begin on '**Ready to Fly**' and will progress to '**Soaring High / Side Kick**' and receive a sticker for good work and behaviour.
- ▶ For an outstanding day, children will receive a '**Role Model/ Super Hero**' certificate.
- ▶ If a child receives a warning, they will move to the '**Watch Out/ Danger Zone**'. This can be rectified by improved behaviour and children can be moved back to '**Ready to fly**'.
- ▶ Upon a second warning, children will be moved down to '**Danger! / Kryptonite**'. This means that the child receives a red mark.
- ▶ Red marks are given for: getting to the '**Danger!**' sign on our class behaviour system, inappropriate physical and verbal behaviour.
- ▶ Blue Marks will be given for not having evidence of completing reading at least 3 times in a week. This will be checked every Friday.

# Times table test and practise

- ▶ By the end of Year 4 all children will sit a government multiplication test, where they will have 6 seconds to answer 25 questions on multiplication facts up to x12.
- ▶ More information will be given to you nearer the time.
- ▶ In the meantime, it is important that your child is continuing to learn and become fluent in multiplication facts up to x12.
- ▶ Children are expected to practise these weekly at home.



# Equipment

- ▶ Please ensure your child is only bringing in a SMALL bag. Currently the children's bags are too large and becoming a trip hazard as they are having to be kept under their chairs in the classroom.
- ▶ Children are only allowed to bring in ONE SMALL pencil case. Any extra will be sent home. Essential equipment will be provided by school.
- ▶ No PE kits or trainers need to in school, as children are now permitted to wear PE kits on their designated PE days.
- ▶ Make sure your child has a water bottle in school every day.
- ▶ No toys allowed.
- ▶ Coats are to be worn to school as the weather gets colder.
