Pick up and drop off

Children in Year 6 are allowed to walk home alone. If your child will be doing so, please pop a note in the contact book the first time they do so the class teacher is aware.

PE days

- ▶ PE lessons will take place on the following days:
- ▶ Spruce – Tuesday and Friday
- ▶ Willow – Thursday and Friday

Please remember that PE kits do not need to be brought into school until further notice. Children should have trainers for PE lessons. These can be kept in school.

Behaviour expectations

- ▶ Each day, every child will begin on '**Ready to learn**' and can progress up the behaviour chart if they are showing excellent learning behaviours.
- ▶ If a child receives a warning, they will move to the '**warning**'. This can be rectified by improved behaviour and children can be moved back to '**Ready to learn**'.
- ▶ Upon a second warning, children will be moved down to '**Red Mark**'. This means that the child receives a red mark.
- ▶ Red marks are given for: getting to the '**Red Mark**' sign on our class behaviour system as well as inappropriate physical and verbal behaviour.

End of KS2 SATs

- ▶ The children will take part in the KS2 SATs in May 2021
- ▶ The pupils will take part in assessments in:
Maths (arithmetic and reasoning)
Reading
SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar)
- ▶ Pupils writing is assessed using teacher judgement.
- ▶ These assessments are carried out during the school day in class.

Further information will be sent out later on in the school year.

Home Learning

- ▶ In Year 6, home learning is compulsory.
 - ▶ Pupils will receive home learning on a Friday.
 - ▶ They will have a week to complete this and it must be returned to school the following Friday.
 - ▶ They will get a maths, spag and reading task each week.
 - ▶ Pupils will also get a list of spellings to learn each week. These will be handed out on a Monday and tested the following Monday.
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- ▶ Further, optional home learning will be available on google classroom.
