







Covid-19 Addendum to Bandon Hill Primary School Behaviour Policy- with effect from October 2020





This addendum is to be used in conjunction with and alongside our full behaviour policy. The rationale behind its creation is to ensure that pupils and staff at Bandon Hill Primary School act in a manner that fully supports the necessary safety measures that have been put in place during the Covid-19 pandemic. Some behaviour concerns referred to in this addendum may previously have been deemed less serious, however if an action now results in the potential compromising of a person's ability to socially distance and stay safe it will now hold very serious consequences. For some children individual Behaviour Plans will continue to be followed and specific Risk Assessments (agreed with Parents / Carers and school staff) will be in place.




Category	Concern Examples	Consequences/Actions
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not taking responsibility to inform an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus. Not following expectations about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal (in line with the "catch it, bin it, kill it" message). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Staff to give reminder of symptoms of the virus. Child reminded of the rules and copy of 'How to stay healthy; how to keep others healthy as a visual aid'- see attached General school behaviour system followed. Parents informed if necessary (i.e. symptoms present in child).
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not following school routine for arrival or departure - once. Not following rules about sharing equipment or other items - once. Not following instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing or sanitising - once. Not moving around school as per specific instructions - once. Not lining up or sitting following instructions to remain 2 metres apart wherever possible. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Staff reminder given. Parents / Carers informed on collection / drop off or by telephone or email. Recorded following behaviour reporting on My Concern. To be monitored and any repeat perpetrators escalated to category 3. General school behaviour system followed.
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not following school routine for arrival or departure correctly – more than once. Deliberately tampering or touching another child's equipment or belongings, despite verbal warning. Deliberately tampering with hygiene materials such as soap or sanitiser, despite verbal warning. Deliberately tampering with bins or the contents of bins, despite verbal warning. Deliberately entering an area or zone that is out of bounds or which may compromise the health of children and staff in another 'bubble group', despite verbal warning. Deliberately attempting to enter another child's bubble group, despite verbal warning. Deliberately misusing toilet areas and facilities, despite verbal warning 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Parent / carer will be contacted immediately and Child may be sent home. A risk assessment will be completed to ascertain their date of return based upon agreement of risk assessment.
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Deliberately coughing or spitting at somebody. Behaviours as outlined on individual Risk Assessments that would lead to the child / staff / other children not being safe. Any action that would usually require the need for restraint and which would severely compromise staff ability to remain socially distanced. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Child will be sent home immediately. A risk assessment must be completed to assess if and when it is safe for child / staff for the child to return.
